FINAL STATEMENT OF REASONS

UPDATE OF INITIAL STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Initial Statement of Reasons is hereby incorporated by reference as the Final Statement of Reasons.

However, the final text was amended to make the following minor grammatical corrections:

- A comma was added after “manufacturer’s” in the last sentence of (a).
- The second “shall” was stricken from (c).
- The second “or” was deleted from (d).
- “Department” was changed to “department” (lower case) in (e).
- Section 25205 was added as an authority section.

The following additional explanatory information is provided:

The term “furnished” is being replaced with “filed” to clarify that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) may refuse to accept any label that is not in compliance with this regulation or the ABC Act, and that just furnishing or giving the label to ABC is not acceptable if it is not in compliance with this regulation or the ABC Act.

Subdivision (e) is being added to clarify that if revisions are made to labels previously filed with ABC, they must be submitted to ABC for filing and acceptance.

LOCAL MANDATES DETERMINATION

These regulations impose no mandates on local agencies or school districts.

No written comments were submitted during the 45-day comment period.

No public hearing was held. The Department neither scheduled a public hearing nor was one requested in response to public notice.
