ABC NAMES NEW DEPUTY DIVISION CHIEF

Sacramento – The Director of the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC), Jerry R. Jolly, has named David Gill Deputy Division Chief for ABC's Northern California Division.

Gill, a 19-year veteran of the Department, joined ABC in 1985, serving as an Investigator and Supervising Investigator in ABC's San Diego District Office. He became Supervising Investigator in charge of the Rancho Mirage District Office in 1991, before being promoted to District Administrator of the Riverside District Office in 2000.

Said Jolly, "Gill's experience and skills as an administrator will be a big asset to the Department in overseeing daily operations of the eleven district and branch offices in Northern California."

As number two man in the Northern Division, Gill replaces Manuel Diaz, who was promoted to Acting Assistant Director in June of this year.

During his years with ABC, Gill was also Firearms Instructor for Southern Division, and an Internal Affairs Investigator.

A native of Pomona, California, Gill was a Police Officer for the City of Coronado before coming to ABC. He is married and has two daughters.
