ABC REVOKES ALCOHOL LICENSE OF SAN JOSE RESTAURANT

San Jose— The California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) has revoked the alcohol license of the Rang Dong Restaurant, 301 East Santa Clara Street, Suite C, in San Jose for multiple alcohol law violations. The ABC took administrative action against the business because of illegal drink solicitations, after-hour sales of alcohol, and violations of the restaurant’s operating conditions.

“We are hoping that our enforcement will help reduce crime and increase the quality of life in this community,” said ABC Director Jerry Jolly.

The ABC completed a one year investigation that produced evidence of multiple violations of California alcohol laws. The violations included the restaurant owner employing and permitting persons to solicit or encourage others to buy them drinks in the licensed premises under a commission percentage, salary or other profit-sharing plan or scheme which is a violation of sections 24200.5 and 25657 of the California Business and Professions Code. In addition, Investigators discovered after hour sales of alcohol and live entertainment, amplified music and dancing which were violations of the license conditions.

The violations occurred in November and December of 2004, March and April of 2005 and September, 2005.
