ABC Revokes License of Mike's Liquor Store in Vallejo

Store sold alcohol to minors three times in a three-year period

Vallejo- On August 1, 2007, the Department Of Alcoholic Beverage Control revoked the alcoholic beverage license of Mike's Liquor Store located at 39 Rancho Square in Vallejo. The revocation resulted from three separate sales of alcoholic beverages to minors within a three-year period.

All three sales occurred during Minor Decoy Operations conducted by the Vallejo Police Department.

The owner of the store can continue to sell groceries and other items but will not be allowed to sell alcohol again nor can the owner sell the license to another person. There will not be any alcohol sold at the store for at least a period of one year and the ABC must approve any new license for any individual who might apply for a license and wants to sell alcohol at the current location.

"This action is part of the department's statewide effort to increase compliance with the law through strong enforcement. ABC wants to send a very clear message that selling or furnishing alcohol to minors will not be tolerated," said ABC District Administrator Justin Gebb.

ABC is a Department of the Business, Transportation and Housing Agency which is under the direction of Secretary Dale E. Bonner, a member of the Governor's Cabinet.
