License Revoked at San Pablo Grocery Store
Store will not be able to sell alcohol indefinitely

San Pablo - Investigators of the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) today, April 18, 2007 posted a Notice of Revocation at Asian Grocery located at 2290 Sanford Avenue in San Pablo, California.

The action was taken after an investigation by San Pablo Police and ABC Investigators. San Pablo Police and ABC Investigators were able to substantiate that employees and the store owner purchased property that they believed was stolen. Receiving purported stolen property is a violation of the California Penal Code.

The alcoholic beverage license has been revoked. The revocation means no alcoholic beverages will be sold at this location for at least one year.

Any person or group of individuals who applies for a new license will be subject to a background investigation by the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control and their application will also be reviewed by local law enforcement and city planners.

San Pablo Police initiated the investigation after receiving complaints about the location in the community. ABC is a Department of the Business, Transportation and Housing Agency, which is under the direction of Secretary Dale E. Bonner, a member of the Governor's Cabinet.
