License Suspended at Eureka Bar for Alcoholic Beverage Law Violations
Red Fox Tavern will not be able to sell Alcohol for 25 Days

Eureka - Investigators of the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) posted a Notice of Suspension at the Red Fox Tavern, an ABC licensed business located at 415 Fifth Street in Eureka, California for multiple alcoholic beverage law violations at the bar.

The action was taken on Thursday, July 12, 2007, after an investigation by ABC Investigators. The license has been suspended because the bar allowed a minor to remain on the premises, served an obviously intoxicated patron, and allowed public drunkenness.

The alcoholic beverage license has been suspended for 25 days which means no alcoholic beverages will be sold during this time.

ABC initiated the investigation after receiving complaints about the location in the community. ABC investigators went undercover on St. Patrick's Day Weekend and developed information that led to the license suspension.

ABC is a Department of the Business, Transportation and Housing Agency under the direction of Secretary Dale E. Bonner, a member of the Governor's Cabinet.
