Two Licenses Suspended at Bars in Mt. Shasta & Dunsmuir

Mt. Shasta & Dunsmuir - Investigators of the California Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) have posted two Notices of Suspension because of illegal drug activity in Mt. Shasta and Dunsmuir. Notices of Suspension were posted at Nebiolini's Vets Club located at 406 North Mt. Shasta Boulevard in Mt. Shasta, and at Two Spirits LLC, located at 5827 Dunsmuir Avenue in Dunsmuir.

The actions were taken after a joint investigation by ABC Investigators and officers of the Mt. Shasta Police Department and Siskiyou County Sheriff's Department. The investigations were initiated after ABC received complaints about the locations in the community.

During the Dunsmuir investigation, that involved the Siskiyou Countywide Inter-Agency Narcotic Task Force (SCINTF), undercover ABC officers were able to purchase illegal drugs from an employee inside the Two Spirits LLC Bar in Dunsmuir. Selling illegal drugs is a violation of the California Health and Safety Code. As a result the bar's license has been suspended for 20 days and will remain inactive until the license can be transferred to another person or persons acceptable to the Department.

In a separate investigation, Mt. Shasta Police substantiated that Nebiolini's Vet's Club Owner Fred Nebiolini was involved in illegal drug activity. As a result, the license of his bar located at 406 North Mt. Shasta Boulevard is suspended for 15 days and will remain inactive until the license can be transferred to another person or persons acceptable to the Department.

No alcoholic beverages will be sold at either location during the suspension periods.

Any person or group of individuals who applies for a new license will be subject to a background investigation by ABC, and the application will also be reviewed by local law enforcement, the City Council and city planners.

ABC is a Department of the Business, Transportation and Housing Agency, which is under the direction of Secretary Dale E. Bonner, a member of the Governor's Cabinet.
