**ABC Investigators Post Suspension Notice at Oakland Store**

**ABC Cracks Down on Alcohol-Related Crime**

**Oakland** - On March 12, 2009 the California Alcoholic Beverage Control suspended the alcoholic beverage license of Sun Hop Fat Supermarket 2, located at 5424 International Boulevard in Oakland. The license is suspended for an indefinite period of time. The enforcement action is a result of an Oakland Police Department - ABC investigation that substantiated evidence of three separate sales of alcoholic beverages to minors within a 16 month period from June, 2006, through October, 2007.

All three sales occurred during Minor Decoy Operations conducted by the Oakland Police Department. The owner of the store can continue to sell groceries and other items but will not be allowed to sell alcohol until the license is transferred to another person or persons. Any new applicant must be acceptable to the ABC and will also be reviewed by the City of Oakland.

“This action is part of an ongoing partnership with Oakland Police to reduce crime and help keep young persons safe,” said ABC Oakland District Administrator Justin Gebb.

ABC is a Department of the Business, Transportation and Housing Agency which is under the direction of Secretary Dale E. Bonner, a member of the Governor’s Cabinet.
