License Suspended at Redding Bar for Disorderly Conduct

“Club 151” will not be able to sell Alcohol for 15 Days

Redding - Investigators of the California Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) today posted a Notice of Suspension at “Club 151”, an ABC licensed business located at 2611 Bechelli Lane in Redding, California because of numerous problems at the bar.

The action was taken after an investigation by ABC Investigators with help from the Redding Police Department. The license has been suspended because the bar has been allowing disorderly conduct including fights, public drunkenness and other problems that has created a drain on local law enforcement resources.

The alcoholic beverage license has been suspended for 15 days which means no alcoholic beverages will be sold during this time. In addition, the bar will be on probation for the next two years and if similar violations occur, more disciplinary action will be taken.

ABC initiated the investigation after receiving complaints from the Redding Police Department following a fight in the bar that resulted in the death of a patron.

ABC is a Department of the Business, Transportation and Housing Agency under the direction of Secretary Dale E. Bonner, a member of the Governor’s Cabinet.
