License Suspended at Redding Bar for Lewd Conduct

“Club Ice” will not be able to sell Alcohol for 30-days

Redding - Investigators of the California Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) today posted a Notice of Suspension at “Club Ice”, an ABC licensed location at 2611 Bechelli Lane in Redding, California because of numerous problems at the bar.

The license has been suspended because the bar has been allowing disorderly conduct including lewd activity, free goods violations and other problems that has created a drain on local law enforcement resources and the ABC.

The alcoholic beverage license has been suspended for 30-days, which means no alcoholic beverages can be sold during this time. In addition, the bar will be on probation for the next two years and if similar violations occur, the licensee can face revocation of their ABC license.

ABC initiated the investigation after receiving complaints from the Redding Police Department. The Club Ice license was suspended for 15-days back in June of 2009 because of disorderly conduct including fights, public drunkenness and other problems that required numerous police responses.

ABC is a Department of the Business, Transportation and Housing Agency under the direction of Secretary Dale E. Bonner, a member of the Governor’s Cabinet.
