ABC Investigators Post Revocation Notice at Azusa Nightclub

Azusa – ABC Investigators have posted a Notice of Revocation at Casa Tequila, AKA D-Club located at 975 W. Foothill Blvd. in Azusa. Today’s action means the location may no longer sell alcoholic beverages.

ABC revoked the license after the Department reviewed numerous calls for service and police reports that occurred between the time period of June of 2006 to June of 2007. Based on the accumulation and severity of criminal activity, the licensee was found to be in operating a Disorderly Premises. All appeals on this revocation have been exhausted.

ABC initiated the investigation due to a complaint originating from the Azusa Police Department, due to the drain of police resources this nightclub required on a weekly basis. The Department reviewed over 200 police reports and calls for service that occurred during the one year period.

Assistant Director, Joseph Cruz, said “This is an outstanding example of two agencies working together to achieve a common goal”. Azusa Police Chief, Robert Garcia said “I applaud their (ABC) actions today to make Azusa a safer community.”

ABC is a department of the Business, Transportation and Housing Agency, which is under the direction of Secretary Dale E. Bonner, a member of the Governor’s Cabinet.
