PR 13-17**California ABC Posts Revocation Notice at Camino Real Restaurante**  
*Bakersfield Location Must Stop Selling Alcohol*

**Bakersfield** – On June 1, 2013, Agents from the California Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) posted a Notice of Revocation at the Camino Real Restaurante located at 3500 Truxtun Avenue in Bakersfield. The alcoholic beverage license has been revoked because the restaurant served alcohol to minor decoys during a time when their license was on stayed revocation (stayed revocation is similar to probation). The two violations resulted in revocation of the license and the current owners may no longer sell alcohol at Camino Real Restaurante.

Back in 2011, ABC suspended the license of the business for 20 days after it was determined that employees of the restaurant served alcohol to a minor who later died in an alcohol-related crash after leaving the business.

ABC agents conducted a TRACE investigation, or Target Responsibility for Alcohol-Connected Emergencies investigation immediately following the May 8, 2010 crash that killed 20 year old Leonel Del Toro. The investigation revealed that Del Toro consumed multiple alcoholic beverages at Camino Real Restaurante just prior to the crash that took his life.

ABC utilized resources from TRACE, a rapid response program for crashes involving minors and alcohol. In 2003, a state-wide TRACE protocol was established with local and state law enforcement agencies to contact ABC when they respond to major injury or fatal crashes involving minors and alcohol.

ABC agents respond immediately to gather evidence and information to help trace how the minors obtained the alcohol, either directly from ABC licensed businesses, or from friends or family.

ABC was awarded a grant to fund the TRACE program by the California Office of Traffic Safety through the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA). ABC is a Department of the Business, Transportation and Housing Agency.
