License Suspended at Salinas Establishment for Operating a “Disorderly House”
“El Callejon” cannot Sell Alcohol until September 7

Salinas - Agents of the California Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) have posted a Notice of Suspension at El Callejon, a bar and restaurant licensed by the ABC. El Callejon has been disciplined because it has been operating a “Disorderly House” and has been a drain on law enforcement services. The premises has been the focus of numerous calls for police services and reported incidents from the Salinas Police Department for fights, assaults, public drunkenness and other problems dating back to October 2011.

ABC filed an accusation alleging a law enforcement problem and disorderly house that involved numerous violations including furnishing alcohol to a minor and allowing a minor to consume inside the premises back on November 30, 2012.

The license has been suspended for 30 days and a revocation order has been stayed for two years. When a revocation order is stayed it means the business is on probation and if there are any new violations then ABC has the authority to revoke the license.

The bar and restaurant owners cannot sell alcohol until September 7, 2013. El Callejon is located at 66 W Alisal Street in Salinas.

ABC is a Department of the Business, Consumer Services and Housing Agency.
