ABC Suspends the License of Bombays in Redding *Case Involved Service of Alcohol to Minors*

(Redding)- ABC Agents posted a 25 day Notice of Suspension today at Bombays, (Double Up Corporation) located at 1730 California Street in Redding.

The suspension means the type 48 ABC licensed business cannot serve or sell alcohol for the next 25 days. The licensee agreed to the penalty.

ABC Agents opened a TRACE investigation immediately after a minor was reportedly involved in a stabbing incident during the early morning hours on May 29, 2014 outside the premises. Upon completing the investigation, Agents established that an employee at the bar served alcohol on May 28, 2014 to two of three minors who were allowed into the bar. One of the minors reportedly stabbed another person in an altercation after leaving the bar.

TRACE stands for Target Responsibility for Alcohol-Connected Emergencies. ABC has conducted hundreds of TRACE investigations since the program's inception. The TRACE program is made possible by a grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) through the National Highway Transportation and Safety Administration. The grant provides funding for in-depth ABC investigations of serious incidents including car crashes, alcohol overdoses, poisonings and assaults where alcohol consumption by minors is involved.
