ABC to Suspend the License of the Fiesta Night Club in San Jose
Owner Agrees to a 60 Day Suspension That Takes Effect January 16

(San Jose) - The California Alcoholic Beverage Control will suspend the alcoholic beverage license of the Fiesta Night Club in San Jose for 60 days effective tomorrow, January 16. The club is located at 3840 Monterey Highway in San Jose. In addition the club's license will be on probation for the next two years.

The license is being suspended for multiple violations including a violent shooting incident that occurred on January 11, 2015. In the most recent incident, four patrons were shot with a firearm inside the premises, and one patron was shot with a firearm outside the premises, resulting in injuries to all of the victims.

ABC has been working closely with the San Jose Police Department and has determined that the licensee permitted disorderly conditions to occur at the premises.

The ABC investigation has revealed that the licensee did not have adequate security measures in place for the January 11, 2015 event. Over 80 officers responded to the scene, along with fire, and medical units.

The facts which constitute the basis for the suspension by the Department are as follows:

In addition to the violent incident on January 11, 2015, the licensee permitted disorderly house conditions multiple times between January 13, 2014 and January 11, 2015 in violation of California Business and Professions Code Section 25601. Police reports document that there were incidents in January, March, July, and August 2014, involving assault with a deadly weapon, a discharged firearm and public drunkenness.
