ABC Posts Three License Suspensions in San Jose

ABC takes action on After Hours Alcohol Sales, Lewd Conduct, Illegal Drink Solicitations & Drug Paraphernalia

SAN JOSE – On August 11, 2015, Agents of the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) posted three separate notices of suspension at three licensed businesses in the city of San Jose.

Agents posted a 30 day suspension at the Dragonfly Lounge located at 4126 Monterey Highway for violations involving lewd conduct, alcohol service during restricted hours, and illegal drink solicitation by employees. In addition, the business is on probation for the next three years and could lose its license permanently if additional illegal activity occurs there.

Agents also posted a 20 day suspension at Union Avenue Liquor, 3649 Union Avenue, for violation of section 11364.7(a) of the California Health and Safety Code, selling or furnishing drug paraphernalia to undercover agents. This business is also on probation for three years and if more violations occur, ABC could revoke the license.

Agents also posted a suspension at the Motif restaurant, 389 South First Street, for failure to comply with food service requirements of its license. The suspension is for 10 days and indefinitely thereafter until the business's kitchen is fully operational.

Undercover investigations conducted by ABC agents in recent months revealed the violations at each of the three businesses. The suspensions are effective immediately and the sale or service of alcohol is prohibited during the suspension periods.

ABC is a Department of the Business, Consumer Services, and Housing Agency.
