ABC Suspends License of the “Redux Lounge” in Walnut Creek
45 Day suspension for business operated as a ‘Disorderly House’

(Walnut Creek, California)- On October 6, 2016, Agents of the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) posted a Notice of Suspension at the Redux Lounge, located at 1411 Locust Street, Walnut Creek. The business is prohibited from serving or selling alcohol for 45 days and the license has been placed on probation for three years.

The suspension is the result of an investigation conducted by the ABC and the Walnut Creek Police Department related to ongoing disorderly operation of the business, as defined by California Business and Professions Code section 25601.

From August, 2014 through July, 2016, police were required to respond and take action at the business numerous times for incidents such as fights, assaults, public drunkenness and disturbing the peace. Required police response created a significant drain on police resources.

Upon completion of the suspension, the ABC could move to permanently revoke the business’s license if the licensee allows similar levels of disorderly activity to occur at any time during the three-year probationary period.

ABC is a Department of the Business, Consumer Services and Housing Agency.
