ABC Revokes License of Los Limones Bar in Modesto

Bar Violated Several Laws

(Modesto) - On May 12, 2011, ABC investigators posted a Notice of Revocation at the Los Limones Bar located at 241 South 7th Street in Modesto. The license has been revoked for multiple violations including possession of controlled substances by a patron, allowing minors to remain in a public premises (underage pole dancers), lewd conduct and illegal drink solicitations.

The Notice of Revocation means the owners of the bar are no longer allowed to sell alcohol at this location. The license has been indefinitely suspended to allow for transfer of the license to another owner or owners.

Back on March 11, 2011, ABC arrested five individuals at Los Limones. Investigators arrested one adult for possession of illegal drugs and cited four minors for entering and remaining in the bar. During the operation ABC Investigators discovered illegal activity including lewd conduct and illegal drink solicitation violations. Four pole dancers performing at the bar were under the age of 21, which included two juveniles. The pole dancers performed lap dances for customers and also violated lewd conduct rules within the Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) Act. The juveniles had told their parents they were at a "sleepover". The bar was licensed as a "public premises" where minors are not allowed to enter and remain; therefore, the four minors were cited for the misdemeanor offense.
